The Housing Act 2004 (Commencement No. 8) (England and Wales) Order 2007

Application of Part 5 of the Housing Act 2004 to residential properties with four bedrooms or more

3.—(1) The types of property referred to in article 2 are—

- (a) a residential property which-
 - (i) is physically complete at the first point of marketing; and
 - (ii) has four bedrooms or more;

and

- (b) a residential property which-
 - (i) is not physically complete at the first point of marketing; and
 - (ii) is expected to have four bedrooms or more once physically complete,

other than a property to the construction of which Regulation 17C of the Building Regulations 2000(1) applies.

(2) The duties under sections 155 to 159 of the Housing Act 2004 shall apply subject to the Home Information Pack (No.2) Regulations 2007(2).
