  5. Dates when a person makes an application for limited leave to remain
  6. Power for an authorised person to require a person to provide biometric information
  7. Power for the Secretary of State to use and retain existing biometric information
  8. Provision in relation to persons under the age of sixteen
  9. Process by which the person’s fingerprints and photograph may be obtained and recorded
  10. Use and retention of biometric information
  11. Subject to regulation 12, any record of fingerprints, photograph, copy...
  12. If a person proves that he is —
  13. (1) The Secretary of State must take all reasonably practicable...

  15. Content of a biometric immigration document
  16. Surrender of a biometric immigration document
  17. Cancellation of a biometric immigration document
  18. Consequences of a failure to comply with a requirement of these Regulations
