**The Commons Act 2006 (Commencement
No. 4 and Savings) (England) Order 2008**

Commencement of provisions

2.—(1) The following provisions of the 2006 Act come into force on 1st October 2008 in relation to the pilot areas—

- (a) sections 1 to 3 (introductory);
- (b) sections 6 to 13 (registration of rights of common);
- (c) sections 14 (statutory dispositions);
- (d) sections 18 and 19 (conclusiveness and correction of the registers);
- (e) sections 20 and 21 (information etc.);
- (f) section 22 and Schedule 2 (non-registration or mistaken registration under the 1965 Act);
- (g) section 23 and Schedule 3 (transitional);
- (h) the entry relating to the 1965 Act in Part 1 of Schedule 6 (repeals relating to registration) to the extent of repealing sections 1 to 7, 10 to 12, 13 (insofar as the repeal of section 13 has not already been commenced), 14 to 16 and 19 of that Act, and section 53 insofar as it relates to that entry.

(2) Section 46 of the 2006 Act (powers relating to unauthorised agricultural activities) comes into force on 1st October 2008.
