# The Export Control (Security and Para-military Goods) Order 2008

Made - - - - 6th March 2008

Laid before Parliament 10th March 2008

Coming into force - - 6th April 2008

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 4, 5 and 7 of the Export Control Act 2002(a), makes the following Order:

### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Security and Para-military Goods) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 6th April 2008.
- (2) In this Order, "the 2003 Order" means the Export of Goods, Transfer of Technology and Provision of Technical Assistance (Control) Order 2003(b).

### **Amendments**

- **2.**—(1) In Schedule 1 to the 2003 Order, insert a new entry PL5001.i. as follows—"Hand-held, spiked batons.".
- (2) In Schedule 2 to the Trade in Goods (Control) Order 2003(c), after paragraph 4 insert—
  - "4A. Hand-held, spiked batons.".
- (3) The reference, in the definition of "controlled goods" in article 2(1) of the Trade in Controlled Goods (Embargoed Destinations) Order 2004(**d**), to Schedule 1 to the 2003 Order shall be construed as a reference to that Schedule as amended by this Order.
