**The Health Care and Associated Professions
(Miscellaneous Amendments and Practitioner
Psychologists) Order 2009 (Commencement No. 1
and Transitional Provisions) Order of Council 2009**

Transitional provisions

3. Until the end of 30th June 2012, the following provisions shall apply as if, where reference is made to a chartered psychologist (however described), that reference is to be treated as a reference to a chartered psychologist (however described) or a psychologist registered in Part 14 of the register maintained by the Health Professions Council—

- (a) sub-paragraph (d) of the paragraph in Schedule 1 to the Mental Health (Approved Mental Health Professionals) (Approval) (England) Regulations 2008⁽¹⁾ (professional requirements);
- (b) paragraph 1(2)(c) of Schedule 4 to the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008⁽²⁾ (the Parole Commissioners – appointment);
- (c) regulation 5(2)(e) of the Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty: Standard Authorisations, Assessments and Ordinary Residence) Regulations 2008⁽³⁾ (eligibility to carry out best interest assessments);
- (d) paragraph 1(d) of Schedule 1 to the Mental Health (Approval of Persons to be Approved Mental Health Professionals) (Wales) Regulations 2008⁽⁴⁾ (professional requirements);
- (e) regulation 5(1)(e) of the Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty: Assessments, Standard Authorisations and Disputes about Residence) (Wales) Regulations 2009⁽⁵⁾ (eligibility to carry out best interest assessments).
