# The Counter-Terrorism Act 2008 (Commencement No. 4) Order 2009

*Made - - - 16th June 2009* 

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 100(5) of the Counter-Terrorism Act 2008(a):

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Counter-Terrorism Act 2008 (Commencement No. 4) Order 2009.
- **2.** The following provisions of the Counter-Terrorism Act 2008 shall come into force on 1st October 2009—
  - (a) sections 40 to 61 (notification requirements);
  - (b) Schedule 4 (notification orders);
  - (c) Schedule 5 (foreign travel restriction orders); and
  - (d) Schedule 6 (notification requirements: application to service offences).
