**The Water Use (Temporary Bans) Order 2010**

This Order is made in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State and the Welsh Ministers by section 76A(2) of the Water Industry Act 1991<sup>(1)</sup>.

The Secretary of State, in relation to prohibitions which may be issued under section 76(1) of that Act<sup>(2)</sup> by water undertakers whose areas are wholly or mainly in England, and the Welsh Ministers, in relation to prohibitions which may be issued under that section by water undertakers whose areas are wholly or mainly in Wales, make the following Order.
