**The Scottish Parliament (Disqualification) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - *13th October 2010*

*Coming into force* - - *14th October 2010*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 13th day of October 2010

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

This Order is made by Her Majesty in Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 15 of the Scotland Act 1998(a).

In accordance with section 115(1) of, and paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 7 to, that Act a draft of this Order was laid before and approved by a resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

Accordingly, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, makes the following Order.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Scottish Parliament (Disqualification) Order 2010 and comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

**Specified office-holders**

2. An office-holder of a description specified in Part I of the Schedule to this Order is disqualified from being a member of the Scottish Parliament.

3. An office-holder of a description specified in column 1 of Part II of the Schedule to this Order is disqualified from being a member of the Scottish Parliament for any constituency specified in relation to that office-holder in column 2 of that Part of the Schedule and for any region specified in relation to that office-holder in column 3 of that Part of the Schedule.

**Revocation of the Scottish Parliament (Disqualification) Order 2007**

4. The Scottish Parliament (Disqualification) Order 2007(a) is revoked.

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order specifies the office-holders who are disqualified from being a member of the Scottish Parliament. Part I of the Schedule specifies the office-holders who are disqualified from being a member of the Parliament and Part II of the Schedule specifies the office-holders who are disqualified from being a member of the Parliament but only for particular constituencies or regions.

The Order revokes and replaces the Scottish Parliament (Disqualification) Order 2007 (S.I. 2007/285).
