**The Travel Concessions (Eligibility)(England) Order 2010**

**Eligibility for travel concessions: age**

2.—(1) Section 93(7)(a) of the Transport Act 1985<sup>(1)</sup>, section 240(5)(a)(i) of the Greater London Authority Act 1999<sup>(2)</sup> and the definition of “elderly person” in section 146 of the Transport Act 2000<sup>(3)</sup> shall have effect as if for the reference to the age of 60 years there were substituted a reference to—

- (a) in the case of a woman, her pensionable age,
- (b) in the case of a man, the pensionable age of a woman born on the same day.

(2) For the purposes of paragraph (1) “pensionable age” has the meaning given by the rules in paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the Pensions Act 1995<sup>(4)</sup>.
