#### Citation

**1.** This Order may be cited as the General and Specialist Medical Practice (Education, Training and Qualifications) Order 2010 (Commencement No.1) Order of Council 2010.

#### Appointed day

- **2.** 1st April 2010 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the General and Specialist Medical Practice (Education, Training and Qualifications) Order 2010—
  - (a) article 3;
  - (b) article 4 and Schedule 1, except in relation to paragraph 12 of that Schedule; and
  - (c) article 7 and Schedule 3, except in relation to paragraph 5 of that Schedule.
