ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (Gainsborough Lane) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *15th February 2010*

Coming into force - - *20th February 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Gainsborough Lane) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20th February 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road) in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road from Folkington Road to Brown Jack Avenue near Polegate;

“Gainsborough Lane” means the road known as Gainsborough Lane at its junction with the trunk road;

“bus stop area” means an area of carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“an A27 bus stop area” means the bus stop areas adjacent to –

- (i) the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road 16 metres west of Gainsborough Lane, or
- (ii) the westbound carriageway of the trunk road 50 metres west of Gainsborough Lane;

“works” mean junction improvement work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 58 hours starting at 2000 hours on Friday 26th February 2010 or on any subsequent Friday until 19th August 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road;
- (b) to enter the trunk road from Gainsborough Lane or to enter Gainsborough Lane from the trunk road; or
- (c) to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A27 bus stop area.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
