The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 19A, 73B and 197(2) of the Licensing Act 2003<sup>(1)</sup>.

In accordance with section 197(4) of that Act<sup>(2)</sup>, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

In accordance with sections 19A(1) and 73B(1) of that Act, the Secretary of State considers it appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives<sup>(3)</sup> to specify the conditions set out in this Order.
