SCHEDULE 3

Amendments relating to policing

Police (Northern Ireland) Act 2000

- 52.**—(1) In section 24(1) (Secretary of State’s long term policing objectives)—
- (a) in subsections (1), (2), (2A) (in both places) and (3) for “Secretary of State” substitute “Department of Justice”;
 - (b) in subsection (3) for “each House of Parliament” substitute “the Northern Ireland Assembly”; and
 - (c) after subsection (3) insert—
“**(4)** Section 41(3) of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954**(2)** applies for the purposes of subsection (3) in relation to the laying of a statement as it applies in relation to the laying of a statutory document under an enactment.”
- (2) In the heading to section 24 for “Secretary of State’s” substitute “Department of Justice’s”.
