# The Local Elections (Declaration of Acceptance of Office) Order 2012

Made - - - - 6th June 2012
Laid before Parliament 13th June 2012
Coming into force - - 9th July 2012

The Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 83(1) and (4) of the Local Government Act 1972(1), makes the following Order:

#### Citation, commencement and application

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Local Elections (Declaration of Acceptance of Office) Order 2012 and comes into force on 9th July 2012.
  - (2) This Order applies in relation to England only(2).

#### Form of declaration of acceptance of office

**2.** For the purposes of section 83(1) and (4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the prescribed form of the declaration of acceptance of office is as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

#### **Revocation of order**

3. The Local Elections (Declaration of Acceptance of Office) Order 2001(3) is revoked.

- (a) Under section 83(3) of the Local Government Act 1972, a declaration for members or elected mayors of a county, district or London borough council shall be made before two members of the council, its elected mayor, its proper officer, a justice of the peace or magistrate in the United Kingdom, the Channel Isles or the Isle of Man, or a commissioner appointed to administer oaths in the Supreme Court. A declaration for members of parish councils shall be made before a member or the proper officer of the council.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order prescribes the form of declaration of office for members and elected mayors of country, district, London borough and parish councils in accordance with section 83 of the Local Government

Status: This is the original version (as it was originally made). This item of legislation is currently only available in its original format.

Act 1972. The declaration must be made within two months of election for county, district and London borough councillors or, in the case of parish councillors, in accordance with section 83(4) of the 1972 Act.

Article 3 revokes the Local Elections (Declaration of Acceptance of Office) Order 2001.

A full impact assessment has not been produced in relation to this Order as no impact on the private and voluntary sectors is foreseen.
