ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junction 46 to Junction 47) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - 14th June 2012

Coming into force - 24th June 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway, the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, lining, traffic loop renewal and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 46 to Junction 47) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 24th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 25th June 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:

- (i) M1 Motorway northbound carriageway from the nose of the northbound exit slip road at Junction 46 (Austhorpe) to the nose of the northbound entry slip road at Junction 47 (Parlington), a distance of 6500 metres;
- (ii) M1 Motorway southbound carriageway from the nose of the southbound exit slip road at Junction 47 to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Junction 46, a distance of 6500 metres;
- (iii) A63 Trunk Road northbound link road from its junction with Austhorpe Interchange (M1 Junction 46) to its junction with Thorpe Park Dumbbell Roundabout;
- (iv) M1 Motorway northbound entry slip road at Junction 46; or
- (v) M1 Motorway southbound entry slip road at Junction 47.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
