**The M62 Motorway (Junction 33, Ferrybridge) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - - *26th July 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *8th August 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway, the A162 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Wakefield, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because road marking renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 33, Ferrybridge) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th August 2012.

2. In this Order; –

“the M62” means the M62 Motorway;

“the A162” means the A162 Trunk Road;

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of M62 at Junction 33, Ferrybridge Interchange;

“a slip road” means any of the following slip roads at Junction 33:

(i) the M62 eastbound and westbound exit and entry slip roads; and

(ii) the A162 northbound and southbound exit and entry slip roads;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 9th August 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the roundabout at its junction with Grovehall Road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in articles 4 and 5 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article;

and nothing in articles 4 and 5 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the roundabout to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.

7. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
