**Transfer of the Secretary of State's functions**

**CHAPTER 2**

**Transfer of the Secretary of State's functions under the 2006 Act**

**48.** In the following provisions of the 2006 Act for “the Secretary of State” and “The Secretary of State”, in each place where it occurs, substitute “DBS”—

- (a) section 30A(1), (6) and (7)(1);
- (b) section 30B(1), (2), (5), (9) and (10)(2);
- (c) section 33(3), (3A), (3D), (4) and (5)(3);
- (d) section 43(1), (2), (5A), (5B), (5C), and (5F)(4);
- (e) section 47(7);
- (f) section 48(1), (2), (2A), (3), (4), (5) and (8)(5);
- (g) section 49(1), (2), (2A), (3), (4), (5) and (8)(6);
- (h) section 50(5)(7);
- (i) paragraphs 19(7) and 22 of Schedule 3.
