2. In this Order—				

"the Association" means the International Development Association established by an agreement dated 29th January 1960 and accepted on behalf of the Government on 14th September 1960(a);

"the Government" means the Government of the United Kingdom; and

"the Resolution" means Resolution No 227 entitled 'Additions to Resources: Sixteenth Replenishment' adopted by the Board of Governors of the Association on 26th April 2011.

#### **Relevant Payments**

- 3. The Secretary of State may, on behalf of the Government—
  - (a) make payment of a further contribution to the Association not exceeding 2,664,000,000 pounds sterling in accordance with arrangements made between the Government and the Association in accordance with the Resolution; and
  - (b) make payment of sums required to redeem any non-interest-bearing and non-negotiable notes or other obligations which may be issued or created by the Secretary of State and accepted by the Association pursuant to the arrangements mentioned in paragraph (a),

in accordance with section 11 of the International Development Act 2002.

The payment approved by this Order will be made pursuant to arrangements made between the Government and the Association in accordance with Resolution No 227 adopted by the Board of Governors of the Association on 26th April 2011 ("the Resolution"). The Order also provides for the redemption of non-interest-bearing and non-negotiable notes issued by the Secretary of State pursuant to those arrangements.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
