EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations 2006 ("the 2006 Regulations").

Regulation 7 of the 2006 Regulations is amended to prohibit the proprietor of a maintained school granting leave of absence to a pupil except where an application has been made in advance and the proprietor and the proprietor considers that there are exceptional circumstances relating to the application.

Regulation 8(1)(k) of the 2006 Regulations is amended to provide that the name of the pupil must be deleted from the school's admissions register where the pupil will cease to be of compulsory school age before the school next meets and either the pupil (where they are 18) or their parent has indicated that they will no longer attend the school or where the pupil does not meet the academic entry requirements for the school's sixth form.

An impact assessment has not been provided for this instrument as no impact on businesses or civil society organisations is foreseen. The instrument has no impact on the public sector.
