Amendments to Legislation

PART 1

Primary Legislation

The Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003

6. The Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003(1) is amended as follows—
- (a) in section 55(6)(a) (duty to give notice to foreign authorities of driving disqualification of a non-UK resident) for the words “section 91A(7)(b)(ii)” substitute “section 91A(7A)(b)”;
 - (b) in section 68 (endorsement of licence: Great Britain)—
 - (i) in the heading for the word “**licence**” substitute “**driving record**”;
 - (ii) for subsection (7) substitute—
 - “(7) Where the person ceases to be disqualified by virtue of section 57(6), the Secretary of State must endorse the relevant particulars on his driving record.
 - (8) In this section “driving record” has the meaning given by section 97A(2) of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988.”;
 - (c) in section 74 (interpretation) in the definition of “counterpart” omit paragraph (a).
