### Unauthorised development

#### Prohibition on the grant of planning permission for unauthorised EIA development

36. The Secretary of State or an inspector must not grant planning permission or subsequent consent under section 177(1)(1) of the Act (grant or modification of planning permission on appeals against enforcement notices) in respect of unauthorised EIA development unless an EIA has been carried out in respect of that development.
