Amendments to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971

4. In paragraph 1(a) of Part 2 (which specifies the drugs which are subject to control under that Act as Class B drugs)—

- (a) after “Amphetamine.” insert—
“N-Benzyl-ethylphenidate.”;
- (b) after “Ethylmorphine (3-ethylmorphine).” insert—
“Ethylphenidate.”;
- (c) after “Glutethimide.” insert—
“Isopropylphenidate (IPP or IPPD).”;
- (d) after “Methcathinone.” insert—
“Methylmorphenate.”
“Methylnaphthidate (HDMP-28).”;
- (e) after “Propiram.” insert—
“Propylphenidate.”;
- (f) after “Zipeprol.” insert—
“3,4-Dichloroethylphenidate.”
“3,4-Dichloromethylphenidate (3,4-DCMP).”;
- (g) after “2-((Dimethylamino)methyl)-1-(3-hydroxyphenyl)cyclohexanol” insert—
“4-Fluoroethylphenidate.”
“4-Fluoromethylphenidate.”
“4-Methylmethylphenidate.”.
