Road Traffic Act 1988

- 1.—(1) The Road Traffic Act 1988 M1 is amended as follows.
- (2) Section 65A (motor cycles not to be sold without EC certificate of conformity) M2 is omitted.
- (3) In section 85(1) (interpretation of Part 2)—
 - (a) in the definition of "EC certificate of conformity" for paragraph (b), substitute—
 - "(b) in the case of a vehicle to which the motorcycle type approval Regulation applies, a certificate of conformity issued by a manufacturer under Article 38 of that Regulation;";
 - (b) in the definition of "light passenger vehicle"
 - (i) for "1(3)", substitute "4";
 - (ii) for "Directive", substitute "Regulation";
 - (c) for the definition of "the motorcycle type approval Directive", substitute—
 ""the motorcycle type approval Regulation" means Regulation (EU) No 168/2013 of the
 European Parliament and of the Council of 15th January 2013 on the approval and market
 surveillance of two- or three-wheel vehicles and quadricycles as it may be amended from
 time to time,".
- (4) In section 86 (index to Part 2), for "Motorcycle type approval Directive" Motorcycle type approval Regulation".
 - (5) In section 108(1) (interpretation), in the definition of "light quadricycle"—
 - (a) for "1(3)(a)", substitute "4";
 - (b) for "Directive", substitute "Regulation".
- (6) In section 183(2) (application to the Crown), for "sections 65 and 65A", substitute "section 65".
