- **9.** In section 76A of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 MI (foreign surveillance operations)—
 - (a) in each of subsections (3) and (10)—
 - (i) omit paragraph (a) and the "or" at the end of that paragraph;
 - (ii) in paragraph (b), omit "other";
 - (b) in subsection (11), omit the definition of "the Schengen Convention".
