#### **CORRECTION**

  - (b) an Irish citizen,
  - (c) a person who has leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom which was granted by virtue of residence scheme immigration rules."."

Page 47, Schedule 1, paragraph 1(1)(a)(ii) (as renumbered as per above): "section 25C(1)(5)(b);" should read "section 25C(5)(b);";

Page 47, Schedule 1, paragraph 1(1)(a)(vii) (as renumbered as per above): "section 28 M(2)(a);" should read section "28M(2)(a);"; and
