**The Counter-Terrorism (Sanctions) (EU Exit) (Commencement) Regulations 2020**

**Commencement of the Counter-Terrorism (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019**

**2.—(1)** The following provisions of the Counter-Terrorism (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019<sup>(1)</sup> come into force on 7th December 2020—

- (a) regulation 1 (citation and commencement);
- (b) regulation 2 (interpretation);
- (c) regulation 4 (purposes);
- (d) regulation 5 (power to designate persons);
- (e) regulation 6 (designation criteria);
- (f) regulation 7 (meaning of “owned or controlled directly or indirectly”);
- (g) regulation 8 (notification and publicity where designation power used);
- (h) the Schedule (rules for interpretation of regulation 7(2)).

(2) All other provisions of the Counter-Terrorism (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 not mentioned in paragraph (1) come into force on ***IP completion day***<sup>(2)</sup>.
