**The Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act
1999 (Commencement No. 24) Order 2022**

Provision coming into force on 12th May 2022

2.—(1) Section 28 (video recorded cross-examination or re-examination) of the Act⁽¹⁾ comes into force on 12th May 2022 in relation to cases where paragraph applies.

(2) This paragraph applies where—

(a) the proceedings take place before the Crown Court sitting at—

- (i)** Sheffield Combined Court Centre;
- (ii)** Newcastle-upon-Tyne;
- (iii)** Doncaster Justice Centre South;
- (iv)** Portsmouth Combined Court Centre;
- (v)** Southampton Combined Court Centre;
- (vi)** Winchester Combined Court Centre;
- (vii)** Truro Combined Court Centre;
- (viii)** Bristol;
- (ix)** Plymouth Combined Court;
- (x)** Isle of Wight Combined Court;
- (xi)** Gloucester;
- (xii)** Bournemouth Combined Court;
- (xiii)** Exeter; or
- (xiv)** Salisbury, and

(b) the witness is eligible for assistance by virtue of section 17(4) (complainants in respect of a sexual offence or a modern day slavery offence who are witnesses in proceedings relating to that offence, or that offence and any other offences) of the Act⁽²⁾.
