The Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act 1999 (Commencement No. 24) Order 2022

Provision coming into force on 12th May 2022

2.—(1) Section 28 (video recorded cross-examination or re-examination) of the Act(1) comes into force on 12th May 2022 in relation to cases where paragraph applies.

(2) This paragraph applies where—

- (a) the proceedings take place before the Crown Court sitting at—
 - (i) Sheffield Combined Court Centre;
 - (ii) Newcastle-upon-Tyne;
 - (iii) Doncaster Justice Centre South;
 - (iv) Portsmouth Combined Court Centre;
 - (v) Southampton Combined Court Centre;
 - (vi) Winchester Combined Court Centre;
 - (vii) Truro Combined Court Centre;
 - (viii) Bristol;
 - (ix) Plymouth Combined Court;
 - (x) Isle of Wight Combined Court;
 - (xi) Gloucester;
 - (xii) Bournemouth Combined Court;
 - (xiii) Exeter; or
 - (xiv) Salisbury, and
- (b) the witness is eligible for assistance by virtue of section 17(4) (complainants in respect of a sexual offence or a modern day slavery offence who are witnesses in proceedings relating to that offence, or that offence and any other offences) of the Act(2).
