The Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act 1999 (Commencement No. 27) Order 2022

Provision coming into force on 11th July 2022

- **2.**—(1) Section 28 of the Act(1) (video recorded cross-examination or re-examination) comes into force on 11th July 2022 in relation to relevant proceedings.
 - (2) Proceedings are relevant for the purposes of paragraph (1) if paragraph (3) applies.
 - (3) This paragraph applies if—
 - (a) the proceedings take place before the Crown Court sitting at—
 - (i) Caernarfon Justice Centre;
 - (ii) Cardiff Crown Court;
 - (iii) Merthyr Tydfil Combined Court Centre;df
 - (iv) Mold Justice Centre;
 - (v) Newport (South Wales) Crown Court;
 - (vi) Preston Crown Court and Family Court (Sessions House); or
 - (vii) Swansea Crown Court; and
 - (b) the witness is eligible for assistance by virtue of section 17(4) of the Act(2) (complainants in respect of a sexual offence or a modern slavery offence who are witnesses in proceedings relating to that offence, or that offence and any other offences).
