**The Courts (Prescribed Recordings) Order 2023**

**Amendment of the Crown Court (Recording and Broadcasting) Order 2020**

**12.** In article 2 of the Crown Court (Recording and Broadcasting) Order 2020(1), in the definition of “judge”, after paragraph (a) insert—

- “(aa) an ex-officio or ordinary judge of the Court of Appeal within the meaning of section 2 of the Senior Courts Act 1981(2), or a Lord Justice of Appeal (England and Wales) (sitting in retirement)(3);”.
