Amendment of the Counter-Terrorism Act 2008

- 17.—(1) The Counter-Terrorism Act 2008(1) is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 54, after subsection (2) insert—
 - "(2A) In the application of this section in England and Wales, the reference in subsection (2)(a) to 12 months is to be read as a reference to the general limit in a magistrates' court (or to 6 months in relation to an offence committed before 2 May 2022)."
- (3) Omit subsection (3)(a).
- (4) In paragraph 15 of Schedule 5 after sub-paragraph (2) insert—
 - "(2A) In the application of this paragraph in England and Wales, the reference in subparagraph (2)(a) to 12 months is to be read as a reference to the general limit in a magistrates' court (or to 6 months in relation to an offence committed before 2 May 2022).".
- (5) Omit sub-paragraph (3)(a).
