Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio Rheoliadau Hadau (Ffioedd) 1985 (fel y'u diwygiwyd). Maent yn rhagnodi ffioedd diwygiedig o ran materion sy'n codi o dan Reoliadau Hadau Grawn 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Planhigion Porthiant 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Hadau Planhigion Olew a Ffibr 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Betys 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Llysiau 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd) a Rheoliadau Hadau (Cofrestru, Trwyddedu a Gorfodi) 1985 (fel y'u diwygiwyd) (rheoliad 2). Maent hefyd yn darparu i ffioedd gael eu talu am arholiadau i arolygwyr cnydau a samplwyr hadau.

Rhestrir y materion y rhagnodir y ffioedd diwygiedig mewn perthynas â hwy yn yr Atodlen i'r Rheoliadau hyn, ac argreffir y ffioedd a oedd yn daladwy cyn i'r Rheoliadau hyn ddod i rym mewn llythrennau italig wrth ochr y ffioedd diwygiedig. Cyflwynwyd ffioedd newydd am archwilio cnydau a gynhyrchwyd o isrywogaethau a gafodd eu cynnig at y Rhestr Genedlaethol ond heb eu hychwanegu ati (neu at y rhestr gyfatebol mewn Aelod-wladwriaeth arall) y bwriadwyd iddynt gynhyrchu hadau ardystiedig, hadau ardystiedig o'r genhedlaeth gyntaf, hadau ardystiedig o'r drydedd genhedlaeth.

Cynyddwyd yr holl ffioedd bump y cant wedi'i dalgrynnu i'r pum ceiniog agosaf ac eithrio yn achos y ffi flynyddol ar gyfer Gorsafoedd Trwyddedig ar gyfer Profi Hadau sydd wedi'i thalgrynnu i'r £1 agosaf.

# 2001 No. 2533 (W.210) SEEDS, WALES

The Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2001

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1985 (as amended). They prescribe revised fees in respect of matters arising under the Cereal Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Fodder Plant Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Oil and Fibre Plant Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Beet Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Vegetable Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended) and the Seeds (Registration, Licensing and Enforcement) Regulations 1985 (as amended) (regulation 2). They also provide for fees to be charged for examinations for crop inspectors and seed samplers.

The matters in respect of which the revised fees are prescribed are listed in the Schedule to these Regulations, and the fees which were chargeable before these Regulations came into force are printed in italics beside the revised fees. New fees have been introduced for crop examinations of crops produced from seed of a variety entered for but not added to the National List (or to the equivalent list in another Member State) intended to produce certified seed, certified seed of the first generation, certified seed of the second generation or certified seed of the third generation.

All fees have been increased by five per cent. rounded to the nearest five pence except in the case of the annual fee for Licensed Seed Testing Stations which has been rounded to the nearest £1.

# The Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2001

Made 10th July 2001
Coming into force 16th July 2001

The National Assembly for Wales, in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1) and (1A)(e) and 36 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a) after consultation in accordance with the said section 16(1) with representatives of such interests as appear to it to be concerned, hereby makes the following Regulations:

#### Title, commencement and application

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2001, shall apply to Wales and shall come into force on 16th July 2001.

#### Amendment

**2.** For Schedules 1 to 6 to the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1985(**b**) there shall be substituted the Schedules set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
