Maent yn rhagnodi ffioedd diwygiedig o ran materion sy'n codi o dan Reoliadau Hadau Grawn 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Planhigion Porthiant 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Planhigion Olew a Ffibr 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Betys 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd), Rheoliadau Hadau Llysiau 1993 (fel y'u diwygiwyd) a Rheoliadau Hadau (Cofrestru, Trwyddedu a Gorfodi) 1985 (fel y'u diwygiwyd) (rheoliad 2).

Rhestrir y materion y rhagnodir y ffioedd diwygiedig mewn perthynas â hwy yn yr Atodlen i'r Rheoliadau hyn, ac argreffir y ffioedd a oedd yn daladwy cyn i'r Rheoliadau hyn ddod i rym mewn llythrennau italig wrth ochr y ffioedd diwygiedig.

Cynyddwyd yr holl ffioedd 5 y cant wedi'i dalgrynnu i'r pum ceiniog agosaf ac eithrio yn achos y ffi flynyddol ar gyfer Gorsafoedd Trwyddedig ar gyfer Profi Hadau y gostyngwyd £335 arni.

### 2002 No. 1870 (W.183) SEEDS, WALES

The Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) (No. 2) Regulations 2002

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1985 (as amended). They prescribe revised fees in respect of matters arising under the Cereal Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Fodder Plant Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Oil and Fibre Plant Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Beet Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended), the Vegetable Seeds Regulations 1993 (as amended) and the Seeds (Registration, Licensing and Enforcement) Regulations 1985 (as amended) (regulation 2).

The matters in respect of which the revised fees are prescribed are listed in the Schedule to these Regulations, and the fees which were chargeable before these Regulations came into force are printed in italics beside the revised fees.

All fees have been increased by 5 per cent. rounded to the nearest five pence except in the case of the annual fee for Licensed Seed Testing Stations which has been reduced by £335.

### 2002 No. 1870 (W.183) SEEDS, WALES

The Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) (No. 2) Regulations 2002

Made 18th July 2002

Coming into force 23rd July 2002

The National Assembly for Wales, acting in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1) and (1A)(e) and 36 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), after consultation in accordance with the said section 16(1) with representatives of such interests as appear to it to be concerned, hereby makes the following Regulations:

#### Title, extent and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (Wales) (No.2) Regulations 2002, shall extend to Wales and shall come into force on 23rd July 2002.

#### Amendment

**2**. For Schedules 1 to 6 to the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1985(**b**) there shall be substituted the Schedules set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
