The County of Gwynedd (Electoral Changes) Order 2002

Name, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order is called the County of Gwynedd (Electoral Changes) Order 2002.
- (2) This Order will come into force—
- (a) for the purposes of proceedings, preliminary or relating to any election to be held on the 6th May 2004, on the 9th October 2003, and
 - (b) for all other purposes, on 6th May 2004.
- (3) In this Order—
- “the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Local Government Act 1972;
- “electoral division” (“*adran etholiadol*”) means an electoral division of the County of Gwynedd constituted by the County of Caernarfonshire and Merionethshire Electoral Arrangements Order 1994⁽¹⁾;
