**The Rhondda Cynon Taff and Vale of
Glamorgan (Llanharry, Pont-y-clun, Penllyn,
Welsh St Donats and Pendoylan) Order 2002**

Name and Commencement

1.—(1) This Order is called the Rhondda Cynon Taff and Vale of Glamorgan (Llanharry, Pont-y-clun, Penllyn, Welsh St Donats and Pendoylan) Order 2002.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 6th April 2002, which is the appointed day for the purposes of the Regulations, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that date this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the boundary map” (“*y map ffiniau*”) means the map prepared by the National Assembly for Wales and marked “Map of the Rhondda Cynon Taff and Vale of Glamorgan (Llanharry, Pont-y-Clun, Penllyn, Welsh St Donats and Pendoylan) Order 2002” and deposited in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Regulations;

“the Regulations” (“*y Rheoliadau*”) means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 as amended⁽¹⁾;

“Rhondda Cynon Taff” (“*Rhondda Cynon Taf*”) means the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taff;

“the Vale of Glamorgan” (“*Bro Morgannwg*”) means the County Borough of the Vale of Glamorgan.

Changes In Community Areas

3. The part of Rhondda Cynon Taff which is in the community of Llanharry and is shown cross-hatched in black on the boundary map shall be separated from that county borough and community and shall form part of the community of Penllyn in the Vale of Glamorgan.
