#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio ymhellach Reoliadau'r Gwasanaeth Iechyd Gwladol (Treuliau Teithio a Pheidio â Chodi Tâl) 1988 ("y prif Reoliadau") sy'n darparu ar gyfer peidio â chodi taliadau'r Gwasanaeth Iechyd Gwladol ac ar gyfer talu treuliau teithio mewn achosion penodol. These Regulations further amend the National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and Remission of Charges) Regulations 1988 ("the principal Regulations") which provide for the remission of National Health Service charges and for the payment of travelling expenses in certain cases.

Mae'r rheoliad 3 o'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio'r prif Reoliadau i ddarparu bod y rheolau sy'n rheoli talu treuliau teithio i ysbytai yng Nghymru hefyd yn gymwys i dreuliau teithio i borthladdoedd ym Mhrydain Fawr ar gyfer rhywun sy'n teithio i wlad y tu hwnt i'r Deyrnas Unedig i gael gwasanaethau'r GIG. Mae rheoliad 4 yn mewnosod 3A newydd i'r prif Rheoliadau i ddarparu y bydd gan bob claf y GIG sy'n cael gwasanaethau y tu hwnt i'r Deyrnas Unedig hawl i gael taliadau am yr holl dreuliau teithio (gan gynnwys, mewn rhai achosion, dreuliau teithio cymar) o borthladd ym Mhrydain Fawr i'r man lle y byddant yn cael y gwasanaethau hynny.

Regulation 3 of these Regulations amends the principal Regulations to provide that the same rules which govern payment of travelling expenses to hospitals in Wales will apply to travelling expenses to a port in Great Britain for a person who travels to a country outside the United Kingdom to receive NHS services. Regulation 4 inserts a new 3A into the principal Regulations to provide that all NHS patients receiving services outside the United Kingdom will be entitled to payment of all travel expenses (including in some cases, those of a companion) from a port in Great Britain to the place where they are to receive those services.

Mae rheoliadau 6-8 yn gwneud diwygiadau canlyniadol sy'n darparu ar gyfer hawliadau am daliadau o dan y darpariaethau newydd.

Regulations 6-8 make consequential amendments providing for claims for payment under the new provisions.

Mae'r diwygiadau a wneir i reoliadau 2,4 a 7 o'r prif Reoliadau hyn yn ychwanegu ceiswyr lloches a'u dibynyddion at y disgrifiad o bobl sydd â'r hawl i beidio â thalu ac i gael taliadau am dreuliau teithio The amendments made to regulations 2, 4 and 7 of the principal Regulations add asylum-seekers and their dependants to the description of persons entitled to receive full remission and payment of travelling (rheoliadau 2,5 a 7 yn y Rheoliadau hyn).

Mae'r diwygiadau a wneir i reoliadau 2, 5A, 8 ac 8A o'r prif Reoliadau yn darparu ar gyfer gwneud taliadau am dreuliau sy'n deillio o deithio i sefydliadau a reolir gan Fyrddau Iechyd Lleol (rheoliadau 2, 6, 9 a 10 o'r Rheoliadau hyn).

Mae'r diwygiadau a wneir i reoliad 2 yn hepgor y diffiniadau o "amount withdrawn", "disabled person's tax credit" a "working families' tax credit", yn rhoi diffiniad newydd o "family" ac yn mewnosod diffiniadau o "child tax credit", "disability element", "gross annual income" a "working tax credit" i mewn i'r prif Reoliadau.

Mae'r diwygiadau yn adlewyrchu'r newidiadau a wnaed gan Ddeddf Credydau Treth 2002 ac yn cynnwys, yn y categorïau o bobl sydd â'r hawl i beidio â thalu ac i gael taliadau llawn o fewn rheoliad 4 o'r prif Reoliadau, bobl sydd yn aelodau o deuluoedd sy'n cael credyd treth i deuluoedd sy'n gweithio a chredyd treth plant, neu sy'n cael credyd treth i deuluoedd sy'n gweithio sy'n cynnwys ychwanegiad anabledd, ac sydd ganddynt incwm llai na therfyn penodedig. Yn ogystal, mae teulu sy'n gymwys i gael credyd treth plant ond nad yw'n gymwys i gael credyd treth i deuluoedd sy'n gweithio hefyd yn cael ei gynnwys o fewn rheoliad newydd 4(2)(q) o'r prif Reoliadau ar yr amod bod ei incwm yn llai na'r un terfyn incwm

Seilir y terfyn incwm ar incwm blynyddol crynswth y teulu (sef yr incwm cyn tynnu treth a chyfraniadau at yswiriant gwladol) a "£14,200" neu'n llai yw'r terfyn ar hyn o bryd (rheoliadau 2 a 5 o'r Rheoliadau hyn).

Mae'r newidiadau a wneir gan y diwygiadau hyn yn disodli'r hawl i beidio â thalu ac i gael taliadau am ffioedd a oedd wedi ei seilio ar gredyd treth i deuluoedd sy'n gweithio a chredyd treth i bobl anabl.

Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn hefyd yn diwygio rheoliadau 7(1)(b) ac 8(4)(a)(i) o'r prif Reoliadau i adlewyrchu'r newidiadau yn y prif Reoliadau sy'n rheoli'r ffioedd am gyffuriau a chyfarpar y GIG sydd wedi eu pennu bellach yn Rheoliadau'r Gwasanaeth Iechyd Gwladol (Ffioedd am Gyffuriau a Chyfarpar) (Cymru) 2001 (rheoliadau 7 a 10 o'r Rheoliadau hyn).

Mae rheoliad 12 yn diwygio Tabl A o Atodlen 1 yn y prif Reoliadau i gynyddu'r terfynau cyfalaf a ddefnyddir wrth gyfrifo i ba raddau y ceir peidio â thalu neu y ceir taliadau, o ran pobl sy'n byw yn barhaol mewn sefydliadau gofal preswyl neu gartrefi nyrsio.

Mae rheoliad 13 o'r Rheoliadau hyn yn diwygio Atodlen 1A i'r prif Reoliadau fel na fydd y darpariaethau sy'n rheoli cyfnod dilysrwydd hysbysiad o hawl myfyriwr i beidio â thalu neu i daliadau am expenses. (regulations 2, 5 and 7 of these Regulations).

The amendments to regulations 2, 5A, 8 and 8A of the principal Regulations provide for payment of expenses incurred in attending establishments managed by Local Health Boards (regulations 2, 6, 9 and 10 of these Regulations).

Amendments made to regulation 2 omit the definitions of "amount withdrawn", "disabled person's tax credit" and "working families' tax credit", substitute a new definition for "family" and insert definitions for "child tax credit", "disability element", "gross annual income" and "working tax credit" into the principal Regulations.

The amendments reflect the changes made by the Tax Credits Act 2002 and introduce into the categories of persons entitled to full remission and payment within regulation 4 of the principal Regulations persons who are members of a family that gets working tax credit and child tax credit or working tax credit with a disability addition and whose income falls below a specified income limit. In addition, a family that is entitled to child tax credit but not to working tax credit is also included within the new regulation 4(2)(q) of the principal Regulations provided its income is below the same income limit.

The income limit is based on the gross annual income (i.e. income before the deduction of tax and national insurance contributions) of the family and is currently "£14,200" or less (regulations 2 and 5 of these Regulations).

The changes made by these amendments replace entitlement to remission and payment of charges that was based on working families' tax credit and disabled person's tax credit.

These Regulations also make amendments to regulations 7(1)(b) and 8(4)(a)(i) of the principal Regulations to reflect the changes in the principal Regulations governing charges for NHS drugs and appliances which are now set out in the National Health Service (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) (Wales) Regulations 2001 (regulations 7 and 10 of these Regulations).

Regulation 12 amends Table A of Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations to uprate the capital limits used in remission and repayment calculations relating to people living permanently in residential care or nursing homes.

Regulation 13 of these Regulations amends Schedule 1A to the principal Regulations is amended so that the provisions governing the period of validity of a notice of entitlement to remission or payment of ffioedd ond yn berthnasol i fyfyrwyr llawn amser.

Regulation 14 contains a transitional provision that provides that where entitlement to remission or payment existed immediately before these Regulations came into force, on the basis of a person being in receipt of working families' tax credit or disabled person's tax credit or being a member of such a person's family, that entitlement will continue until 31st July 2003.

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 83A, 126(4) and 128(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) hereby makes the following Regulations:

## Citation, commencement, interpretation and application

- 1.-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and Remission of Charges) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003 and will come into force -
  - (a) except for regulation 12, on 6th April 2003, and
  - (b) regulation 12, on 7th April 2003.
- (a) 1977 c.49 ("the 1977 Act"); section 83A was inserted by section 14(1) of the Social Security Act 1988 (c.7) and amended by paragraph 6 of Schedule 2 to the Health and Medicines Act 1988 (c.49), by paragraph 18(5) of Schedule 9 to the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990 (c.19) ("the 1990 Act") and by paragraph 40 of Schedule 1 to the Health Authorities Act 1995 (c.17).

Section 126(4) was amended by section 65(2) of the 1990 Act and by Schedule 4, paragraph 37(6) to the Health Act 1999 (c.8).

See section 128(1), as amended by section 26(2)(g) and (i) of the 1990 Act, for the definitions of "prescribed" and "regulations".

- (2) In these Regulations, "the principal Regulations" ("*y prif Reoliadau*") means the National Health Service (Travelling Expenses and Remission of Charges) Regulations 1988(a).

"disability element" means the disability element of working tax credit as specified in section 11(3) of the Tax Credits Act 2002;

"gross annual income" means income that is calculated for a tax year for the purposes of Part I of the Tax Credits Act 2002 in accordance with regulations made under section 7 of that Act;

"local health board" has the meaning assigned to it by section 16BA of the Act(c);

"port" includes an airport, ferry port or international train station in Great Britain from which an international journey begins;

"working tax credit" ("credyd treth i bobl sy'n gweithio") means working tax credit under section 10 of the Tax Credits Act 2002;".

- (4) For the definition of "family" substitute-
  - ""family" has the meaning assigned to it by section 137(1) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(**d**) as it applies to income support, except that-
    - (a) in regulation (4)(2)(q) it has the meaning assigned to it by regulation 2(2) of the Tax Credits (Definition and Calculation of Income) Regulations 2002(e);

- (2) In paragraph (3)(a), after the words "in attending a hospital" insert "or any other place".
- (3) In paragraph (3)(b), for the words "health authority" substitute "local health board".
- (4) After paragraph 3(b), insert the following sub-paragraphs-
  - "(c) in attending an establishment managed by a local health board for the purpose of availing himself of services provided under the care of a consultant in pursuance of the Act,
  - (d) in travelling to a port in Great Britain for the purpose of travelling to a destination outside the United Kingdom in order to receive treatment provided pursuant to arrangements made under section 23 of the Act or paragraph 13 of Schedule 2 to the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(c),".

# **Insertion of regulation 3A into the principal Regulations**

**4**. After regulation 3 of the principal Regulations insert the following regulation-

#### "Entitlement to payment for travel abroad

**3A.**-(1) Where a person receives services provided outside the United Kingdom pursuant to arrangements made under section 23 of the Act or paragraph 13 of Schedule 2 to the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990, that person is entitled, subject to paragraph (2), to payment or repayment of the whole amount of the travelling expenses incurred by him in travelling from a port in Great Britain to a destination outside the United Kingdom in order to receive treatment there (including the travelling expenses of a

- companion in a case where it is necessary on medical grounds that the person should be accompanied).
- (2) The entitlement to payment in paragraph (1) is dependent upon the health service body which has made the arrangements agreeing the mode and cost of the travel before costs are incurred.
- (3) For the purposes of this regulation and regulations 3(3)(d), 5A, 7B and 8 "health service body" means a local health board, an NHS Trust or the National Assembly for Wales.".

      - (b) in any other case to any person mentioned in paragraph (2) who, at the time when the relevant charges are made or when the relevant travelling expenses are incurred, is a person described in paragraph (2).
    - (2) The persons described in this paragraph are-

      - "(n)an asylum-seeker for whom support is provided under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999; or".
