**The Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003 (Commencement  
No.2 and Savings) (Wales) Order 2004**

**Name, interpretation and application**

1.—(1) This Order is called the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003 (Commencement No.2 and Savings) (Wales) Order 2004.

(2) In this Order—

- (a) “the commencement date” (“*y dyddiad cychwyn*”) means 30 September 2004; and
- (b) references to sections and Schedules are, unless otherwise stated, references to sections of, and Schedules to, the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003<sup>(1)</sup>.

(3) This Order applies to Wales.

**Provisions coming into force on the commencement date**

2. The following provisions shall come into force on the commencement date, subject to the savings in the Schedule to this Order—

(a) in Part 2 (housing)—

- (i) section 13 (injunctions against anti-social behaviour on the application of certain social landlords);
- (ii) section 14 and Schedule 1 (security of tenure: anti-social behaviour) (demoted tenancies) in so far as they confer the power to make regulations;
- (iii) section 16 (proceedings for possession: anti-social behaviour); and
- (iv) section 17 (devolution: Wales);

(b) in Part 9 (miscellaneous powers) section 91 (section 222 of the Local Government Act 1972<sup>(2)</sup>: power of arrest attached to injunction).
