**The Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000
(Commencement No. 7) (Wales) Order 2005**

Appointed days

2. 31 May 2005 is the day appointed for the coming into force of—
 - (a) section 51 of the Act (amendments relating to definitive maps and statements) insofar as it gives effect to the following provisions of Schedule 5 to the Act—
 - (i) paragraph 8 (consolidation of definitive maps and statements),
 - (ii) paragraph 10 (applications for certain orders under Part III),
 - (iii) paragraph 11 (procedure in connection with certain orders); and
 - (b) section 57 of the Act (creation, stopping up and diversion of highways) insofar as it gives effect to the following provisions of Schedule 6 to the Act—
 - (i) paragraph 2 (duty to have regard to agriculture, forestry and nature conservation),
 - (ii) subject to article 5 of this Order, paragraph 3 (amendment of section 31 of the 1980 Act relating to the dedication of a way as highway presumed after public use for 20 years),
 - (iii) paragraph 9(1) to (3) (diversion of footpaths and bridleways),
 - (iv) paragraph 11 (diversion of footpaths and bridleways crossing railways),
 - (v) paragraph 14(1) and (4)(a) (supplementary provisions),
 - (vi) paragraph 20(a) to (c) (interpretation), and
 - (vii) paragraph 24 (delegation of function of making determination).
