**The Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004  
(Consequential Amendments) (Wales) Order 2005**

**Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1999**

- 51.**—(1) The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1999<sup>(1)</sup> are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 23(1) (persons by whom theory tests may be conducted)—
- (a) in paragraph (d), omit the words “In Wales, a person appointed by the chief officer of any fire brigade maintained in pursuance of the Fire Services Act 1947 or,”; and
  - (b) after paragraph (d), insert—
    - “(da) in England or Wales, a person appointed by any fire and rescue authority for the purpose of testing employees of any fire and rescue authority;”.
- (3) In regulation 24(1) (persons by whom practical and unitary tests may be conducted)—
- (a) in paragraph (c), omit the words “In Wales, a person appointed by the chief officer of any fire brigade maintained in pursuance of the Fire Services Act 1947 or,”; and
  - (b) after paragraph (c), insert—
    - “(ca) in England or Wales, a person appointed by any fire and rescue authority for the purpose of testing employees of any fire and rescue authority;”.
