**FOOD, WALES**

**The Food Hygiene (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006**

*Made* - - - - - *13 June 2006*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *15 June 2006*

The National Assembly for Wales, being designated<sup>(1)</sup> for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(2)</sup> in relation to measures relating to food (including drink), including the primary production of food, in exercise of the powers conferred by that section, makes the following Regulations:

**Title, commencement and application**

1. The title of these Regulations is the Food Hygiene (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006, they come into force on 15 June 2006 and they apply in relation to Wales.

**Interpretation**

2. In these Regulations—

“the Principal Regulations” (“*y Prif Reoliadau*”) means the Food Hygiene (Wales) Regulations 2006<sup>(3)</sup>;

**Amendment of the Principal Regulations**

3. The Principal Regulations are amended in accordance with regulations 4 and 5 of these Regulations.

4. In the Welsh text of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of regulation 5 (Enforcement) insert the words “*neu'r awdurdod bwyd*” after the words “*gan yr Asiantaeth*”.

5. In the Welsh text of paragraph (9) of regulation 13 (Analysis etc. of samples) substitute the words “*rheoliad hwn*” for the words “*Rheoliadau hyn*”.
