**The Commons Registration (General)  
(Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2007**

The Welsh Ministers make these Regulations in exercise of the powers vested in them<sup>(1)</sup> by section 19(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965<sup>(2)</sup>:

- (1) In relation to Wales, the functions of the Minister were transferred to the Secretary of State for Wales by the Ministry of Land and Natural Resources (Dissolution) Order 1967 (S.I. 1967/156). The functions of the Secretary of State for Wales were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) and are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers by virtue of section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32).
