# **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A4042 Trunk Road (Edlogan Way Roundabout, Cwmbran, Torfaen) (Temporary Traffic Prohibition) Order 2011

Made 07 February 2011

Coming into force 14 February 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newport to Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon;

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 14 February 2011 and its title is the A4042 Trunk Road (Edlogan Way Roundabout, Cwmbran, Torfaen) (Temporary Traffic Prohibition) Order 2011.

#### 2. (1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means that length of the A4042 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 22:00 hours on 14 February 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.
- **3**. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.
- **4**. The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such an extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- **5**. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

### **SCHEDULE**

That length of the northbound and southbound carriageways of the trunk road from a point 68 metres southeast of the centrepoint of the Cwmbran roundabout to a point 35 metres northeast of the centrepoint of the Turnpike roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of the Edlogan Way roundabout.
