The A483 Trunk Road (Ffairfach Level Crossing, Ffairfach, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012

Made 20 September 2012

Coming into force 29 September 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of proposed road works.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on the 29 September 2012 and its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Ffairfach Level Crossing, Ffairfach, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the A483 trunk road known as Heol Cennen at Ffairfach in the County of Carmarthenshire that extends for a distance of 50 metres either side of the Ffairfach level crossing;

"works period" (*"cyfnod y gwaith"*) means that period commencing at 21:30 hours on 29 September 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as traffic signs indicate the application of the prohibition referred to therein.

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
