**The Coleg Menai Further Education
Corporation (Dissolution) Order 2012**

This Order is made in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 27 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992⁽¹⁾ (“the Act”) and now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers⁽²⁾.

In accordance with section 27(2) of the Act, Llandrillo College Further Education Corporation⁽³⁾ has consented to the transfer of the property, rights and liabilities of Coleg Menai Further Education Corporation⁽⁴⁾.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with Coleg Menai Further Education Corporation in accordance with section 27(7) of the Act.

Accordingly, the Welsh Ministers make the following Order:

- (2) The functions of the Secretary of State under section 27 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1. The functions of the National Assembly for Wales were transferred to the Welsh Ministers by virtue of paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32).
- (3) Established as Llandrillo Technical College by the Education (Further Education Corporations) Order 1992 (S.I. 1992/2097). The name was changed to Llandrillo College with effect from 1 August 1994.
- (4) Established by the Education (Further Education Corporations) Order 1994 (S.I. 1994/1449).
